Further, I understand that my child may be denied involvement from any activity for safety precautions or as penalization for disobedience of camp rules at the discretion of Officials or volunteers. # About Camp Staff

Youth Camps are operated by the Eastern North Carolina Church of God Executive Offices located in Kenly, North Carolina, under the direct supervision of the State Youth and Christian Education Director and the State Youth Board. A complete background check is done for every worker's application that we receive. We reserve the right to make decisions which are in the best interest of camp as it relates to staff and camper environment. Counselors are to be a minimum of 18 years of age, while all other camp staff are to be a minimum of 15 years of age. All workers must have an endorsement signature from their local Church of God pastor. All workers are required to attend the mandatory worker's orientation prior to each camp. We do not discriminate on the basis of race, sex, or nationality.

## FIRST AID

- > All medications will be collected at the beginning of camp and will be administered only by the camp nurse.
- > So we may more easily identify your child, please bring a picture if your camper needs to take medication.
- > Prescriptions should be clearly labeled (send only the exact amount needed for the time at camp.)

## VISITOR POLICY

For the protection of all campers, all visitors must register at the State Office upon arrival. Visitors are not permitted to stay overnight, but are welcome to attend the worship services. Visitors will be asked to leave the grounds at the dismissal of each worship service.

Walk-on campers will be accepted the day of their camp as availability and space permits. Walk-on campers must have their camper application signed by their parent or guardian and their pastor.

Scholarships: Limited scholarships are available through the State Youth Department, per State Youth Board approval only. To apply, pastors must call and request the scholarship request form, complete, and return to the State Youth Department. All scholarship requests must be postmarked by June 1. Eligibility applies only to underprivileged and low income families associated with the Church of God.

Refund Policy: Cancellations will be honored if requested fourteen days prior to the actual camp start date. All refunds will be processed after camps end in July.

Insurance: We partner with parents to provide medical/injury insurance coverage for every child and should medical attention be required, you will be notified as soon as possible with all the important information. Safety for your child is important to us. Our insurance is secondary coverage.

Freebies: All campers who register before June 1 will receive a free t-shirt at High School Camp, Middle School Camp, and Elementary School Camp. PLEASE LIST THE CAMPER SHIRT SIZE WHEN FILLING OUT THE APPLICATION! Changing of t-shirt sizes when registering on opening day of camp will not be permitted.

Confirmation of Attendance: When the camper application is received, a letter of confirmation will be emailed with more camp information. Please make sure your email address is provided on your application. If you do not receive your confirmation email two weeks after sending your camp application, please call the office at 919.284.3039 x206. Applications must be completed in their entirety in order to be processed.

## DAMAGED, LOST, AND FOUND POLICY

We are not responsible for any personal items lost or damaged. Lost items will be held in safe keeping for thirty days only! Afterwards, they will be disposed of. Regrettably, we cannot mail lost items. Campers should carefully pack their bags and double-check their areas to avoid left items!
